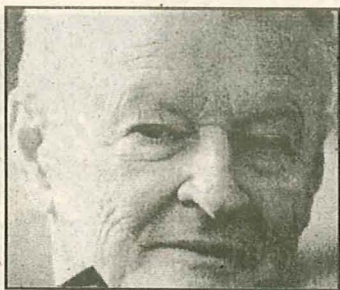


Piast Institute Announce Luncheon Guest Speaker



Hamtramck, MI - The Piast Institute of Hamtramck has announced that former National Security Advisor, Dr. Zbigniew Brzezinski, will be the special luncheon speaker at its Third Annual Dekaban Lecture on September 23, 2005 at the Detroit Athletic Club.

Dr. Brzezinski is currently the Robert G. Osgood Professor of American Foreign Policy at Johns Hopkins University and Counselor at the Center for Strategic & International Studies, also served as President Jimmy Carter's National Security Advisor. He will speak on the current situation in the world and central Europe.
