

Free play tells woman's story of Nazi resistance

The Hamtramck-based Piast Institute and the University of Detroit Mercy are hosting a free performance of "First Of All I Am a Human Being," a play based on a true story about a young Polish woman who worked with the Polish Underground during World War II as it resisted the Nazis.

The play will be presented at 2 p.m. Feb. 16 at the Marygrove College Theater in the Liberal Arts Building, 8425 W. McNichols. The free tickets are available on a first-come, first-served basis and can be obtained from the Piast Institute by calling 313-664-0321.
